Randall Lynn Samson, a student in the College of Engineering and Technology at UNL, has been named recipient of a \$500 Nebraska Sand, Gravel and Ready Mixed Concrete Association Scholarship.

Samson is a senior from Omaha majoring in civil engineering and will be doing research in the area of concrete.

Samson is president of the civil engineering honor society, Chi Epsilon, and also is a member of the student branch of American Society of Civil Engineers.

UNL Physics Prof. James Samson has received a \$50,000 grant from the National Science Foundation to study effects of light on gases.

The grant is part of the \$408,000 Samson has received over the last four years from both the Foundation and the National Aeronautics and Space Administration (NASA) who finance his studies.
