

State higher education hearings await new date

The public hearing on the Nebraska system of higher education, postponed last Saturday because of snow, has not yet been rescheduled.

Sen. Jerome Warner, chairman of the Nebraska Legislature's Study Committee for Post-Secondary Education, said his committee will decide a new date today.

Warner said the committee hopes that by scheduling hearings for each of the state's post-secondary schools, it will receive input from "those who don't have a chance to go to the statehouse."

He said that in the past, the Legislature conducted a "variety of coordinating meetings dealing with establishing a third group which has always been unsuccessful in getting any legislation."

"The committee will have several meetings before next fall," he said, "and we

should have preliminary recommendations by then."

Warner said budgeting problems may decrease next year if his committee can produce effective inter-school coordination.

"Effective coordination and responsibility for the budget must go together," he said. "We want to find the appropriate guidelines for budget allocations."

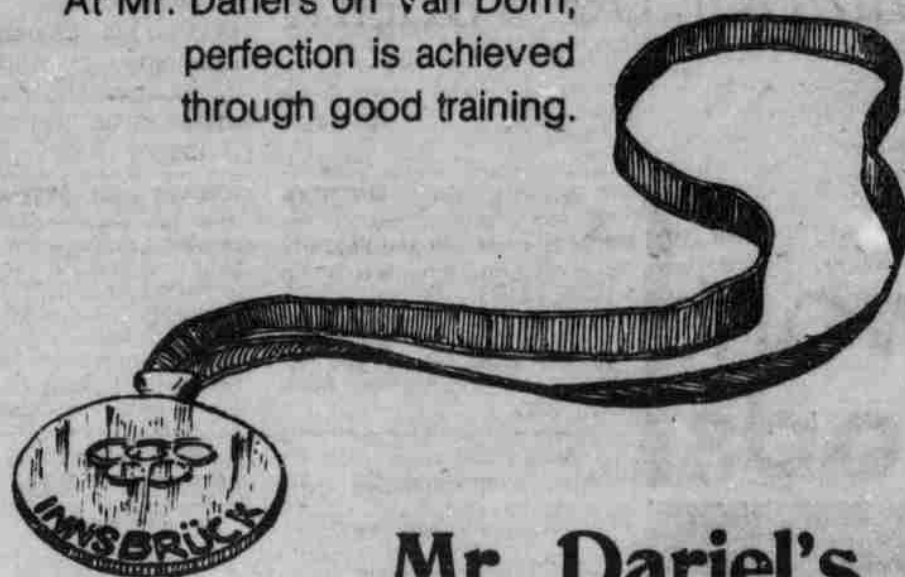
Warner said the committee also is searching for answers to several questions, including what the university's proper mission is and who is, and who should be, determining it.

"There won't be a change overnight," Warner said of his committee's goals. "But there should be some noticeable results."

He added that the committee is less concerned with attracting large crowds than "people who will give us ideas."

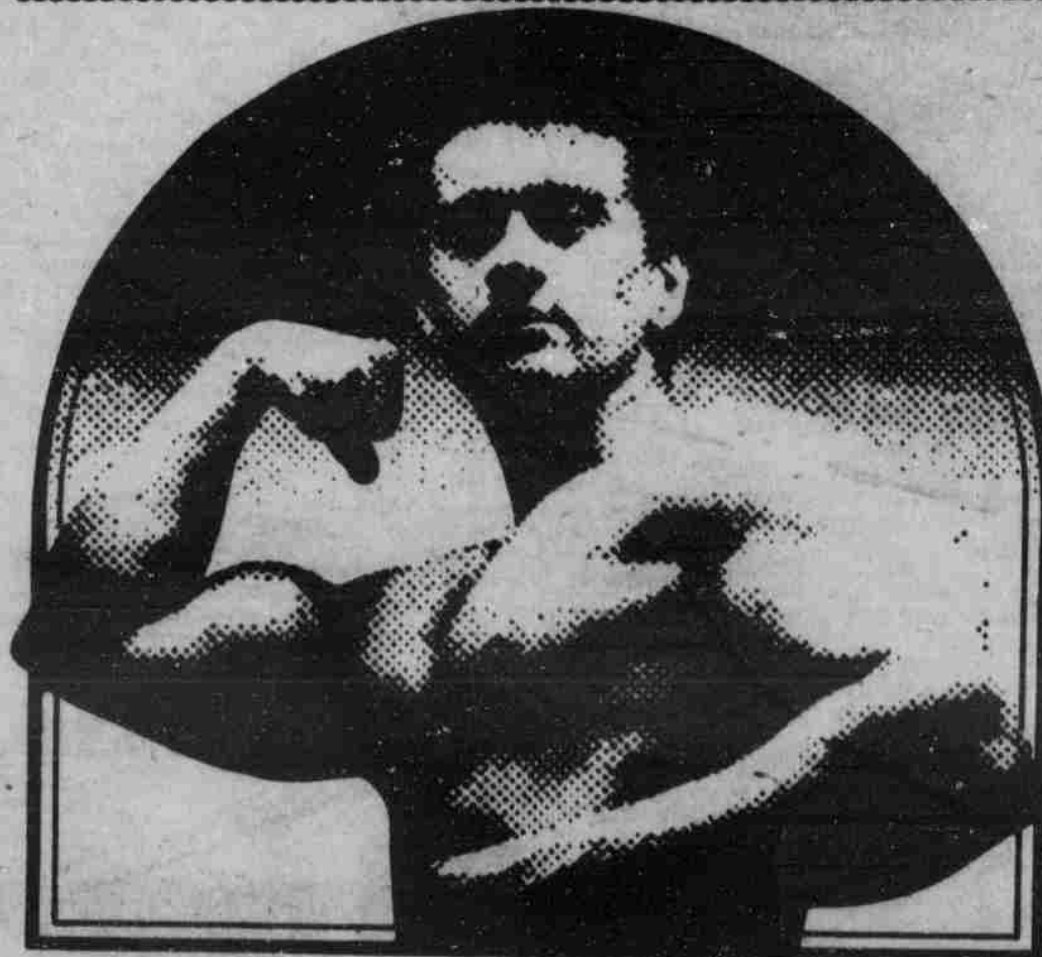
