

CSL rejects appeal motion

After hearing what some Council on Student Life (CSL) members considered veiled threats, CSL voted to deny a motion for an appeal hearing concerning the ASUN Graduate College elections.

Frank Thompson, an economics graduate student from Lincoln, appeared before CSL stating he was concerned because graduate students were not represented on ASUN.

The ASUN Student Court decided April 1 that no Graduate College candidates could be certified as elected to ASUN because of discrepancies with the March 17 elections. A new election will be held April 14.

Thompson said he had petitioned the court for an injunction stating that no senators be seated at ASUN until the problem with graduate candidates is resolved.

Thompson said the injunction was denied, and said he was dissatisfied because no written reason was given. The decision was reached Wednesday afternoon.

CSL members said they did not think they had the au-

thority to hear the appeal because no representative of the court was present and because they had no written information concerning the matter.

No motion was before CSL during this discussion. CSL member Chip Lowe made a motion that discussion be discontinued and that the council move to other agenda items.

Thompson then said he demanded a vote by CSL and added "you better believe I'm going to go out and get a lawyer" and "spend as much money as possible" getting graduate candidates seated.

CSL also defeated a motion that the Fees Allocation Board (FAB) consider alternatives to reduce the amount of student fees appropriated to student organizations so fees would not increase.

CSL members voting against the motion said they thought the council should not "second guess" FAB's work concerning allocation of student fees.
