

# BEOG decision slated for May

The fate of supplemental appropriations for the Basic Education Opportunity Grant (BEOG) program should be decided in early May, said Debi Knight, a UNL financial aid adviser. UNL should know by late May what its appropriation is, she added.

The U.S. Senate is scheduled to vote on a \$791 million supplemental appropriation when it returns from Easter recess on April 26. If passed, the bill will go to President Gerald Ford for approval.

The U.S. House of Representatives April 13 approved the appropriation bill, 318-68. The appropriation would bring the program's total budget to about \$1.3 billion for the 1976-77 academic year.

Knight said she was surprised at Congressional support for the program.

The House Appropriations Committee had recom-

mended a \$476 million supplement, but an amendment introduced by Rep. David Obey, D-Wis., added \$315 million to the recommendation.

The additional appropriation was sought by BEOG officials when they realized the number of eligible students would exceed original estimates for 1976-77. The program is budgeted a year in advance, Knight said.

This year, about 74 per cent of the BEOG applicants or 1.3 million recipients qualified for aid, said Diane Sedicum, assistant to the director of the BEOG program.

In 1973-74, 366 UNL students received BEOG grants totalling \$82,146 and 723 students received BEOG aid totaling \$256,709 in 1974-75. Last semester, 1,172 students received \$532,190, averaging about \$454 a recipient, Knight said.
