12:30 p.m. four or five days a week or MWF—1 to 3 p.m., Wednesday.

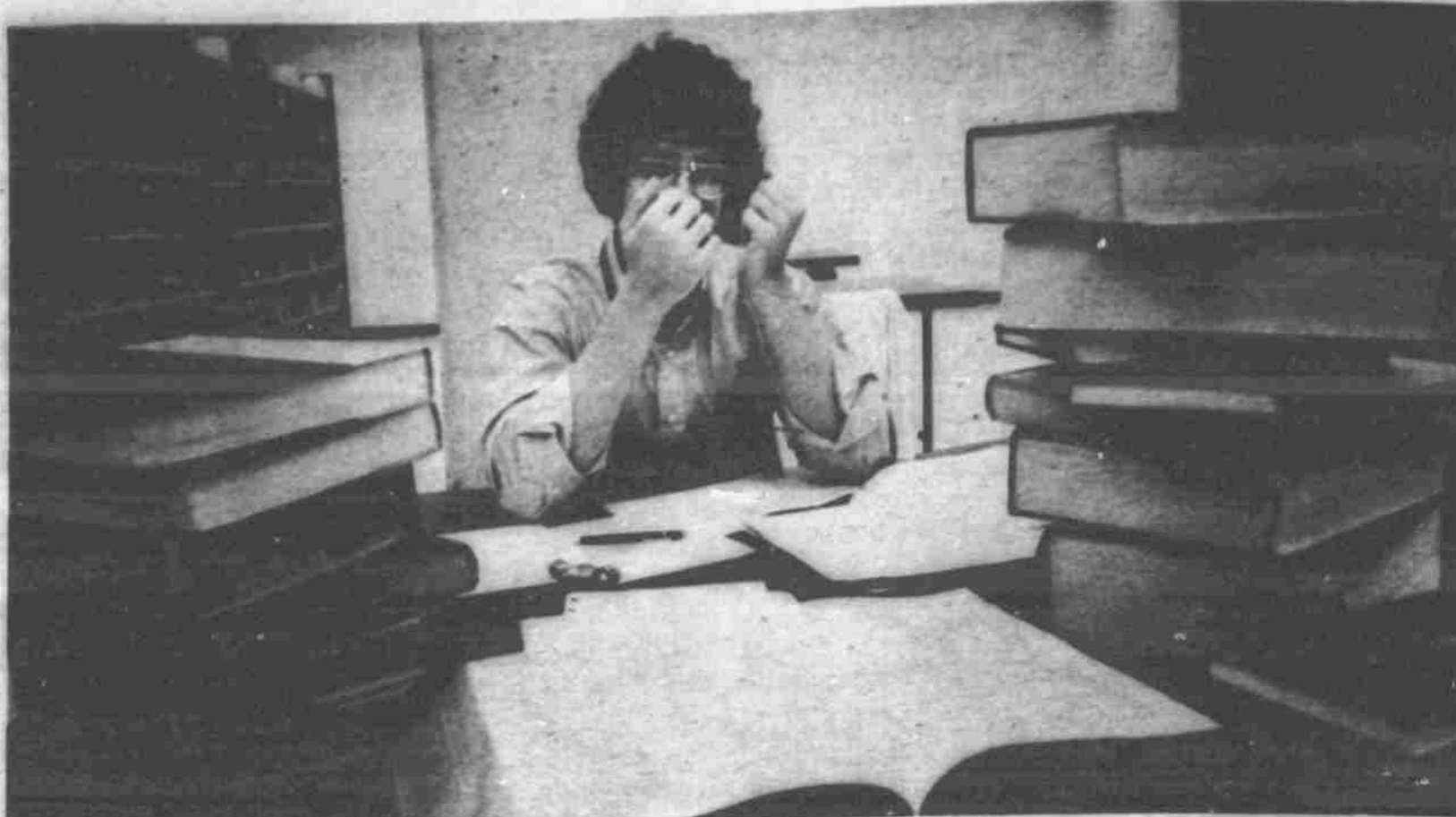
