In addition, the society and individual jazz musicians are receiving exposure from monthly jam sessions at The Zoo (and sporadic appearances at other local establishments). Because of this exposure, several new jazz groups have formed in the Lincoln area.

The Lincoln Jazz Society will have a group of musicians playing at the Lincoln Foundation Gardens, 15th and N streets, to assist in the opening of the downtown mall at noon Sept. 9.
