CBA hosts Britisher for executive program

British House of Commons member Ian Wigglesworth will speak at 3:30 p.m. today in the third floor lounge of the College of Business Administration Bldg.

Besides discussing Britain's role in Europe, Wigglesworth said he will talk about the European Economic Community, consumer affairs, taxation and financial and economic policies.

Wigglesworth is this year's first guest of CBA's Executive-In-Residence Program, which Smith said brings top business people and administrators in government, business and education to speak on the UNL campus.

"It's not a program we spend money on here," Smith said. He added that although CBA selects them, the guests' organizations sponsor the program as part of company educational relations. The U.S. State Dept. is sponsoring Wigglesworth's visit.

Smith said the invited guests are distributed among sections representing general and specialized fields of business, as well as government officials and people who will discuss current issues and ethics.

Past executives-in-residence have included representatives from General Motors, Phillips Petroleum Co., the Navy and the U.S. Department of Commerce.
