

# Palms Cafe adds variety

A San Francisco palm has been transplanted in Lincoln to give residents a variety in cuisine.

With its name taken from a San Francisco bar, the Palms Cafe, 235 N. 11th St., could easily be the most interesting restaurant in Lincoln. It is the only restaurant offering brews from an Italian espresso machine, fruits, vegetables and bread, purchased and prepared daily, atmosphere with a 20s and 30s flair, a vegetarian menu and a tea time scheduled every afternoon.

Over the noon hour, a European custom is practiced by willing diners.

The cafe is a branch of Dirt Cheap Enterprises. According to owner Terry Moore, "The idea of a restaurant came about because of the fact that Lincoln has such a slim selection of types of places to eat. We figured that a vegetarian restaurant was unusual and that there was a need for it."

The building was purchased in February 1975. After seven months of stripping the inside of the building and refurbishing it, the Palms was ready for business.

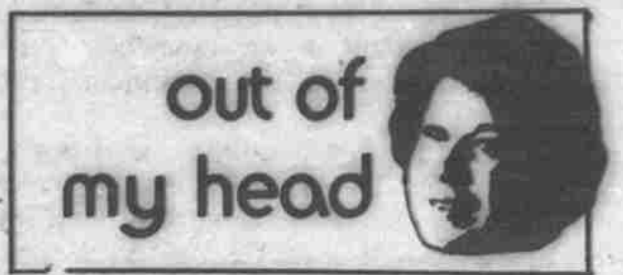
"We never had restaurant experience. Initially we started with a manager," said Moore. "The main concern was atmosphere and food. Good service is provided due to the cooperative effort of the people working together—they make it go."

The dining area is comfortable, furnished with old furniture that Moore and his wife purchased at auctions.

The original red brick walls have been accented by a brick floor, and plants hang from the skylight in the center of the restaurant.

On a busy day, there will be four people in the kitchen, and four waiting tables.

Instead of waiting to be seated at a table for one, customers dine with others at the same table.



The Palms Cafe is open Monday through Saturday, 11 a.m. to 9 p.m. Lunch is served from 11 a.m. to 3 p.m., tea time is from 3 to 5 p.m., and dinner is from 5 to 9 p.m.

The menu accommodates a variety of tastes. There are daily soups and specials, entrees ranging from fried rice to salads, nibblers and side dishes.

Sandwiches from the standard peanut butter and jelly to the avocado deluxe are available, likewise salads and deserts.

All of these dishes are cooked from scratch. Depending on your eating habits, a meal at the Palms might be a worthwhile venture.



The Palms Cafe is the only restaurant in Lincoln serving the distinctive and strong European espresso coffee.

The following are the varieties of espresso offered by the restaurant:

- Espresso Romano (espresso with a twist of lemon).
- Espresso Italiano (espresso with steamed milk).
- Cappuccino Italiano (two-thirds espresso and one-third frothed chocolate milk).
- Cafe au Lait (one-third espresso and two-thirds steamed milk).
- Cafe Borgia (espresso with frothed chocolate milk, whipped cream and grated orange).

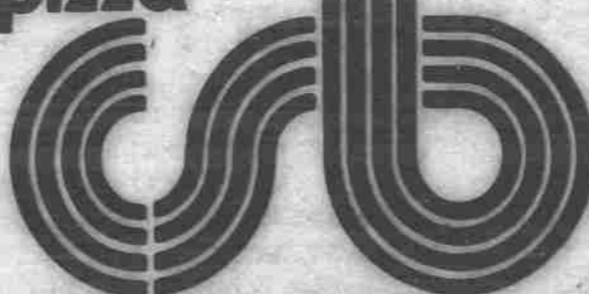
