

# 'Emergency' said not real

An emergency reported in a letter to the editor of the Sept. 9 Daily Nebraskan was not a real emergency, said Dr. Kenneth Hubble, University Health Center (UHC) director.

"It was not a bonafide emergency, and the dependents of students are not eligible for medical care here," Hubble said.

The letter concerned an emergency in which the parents of a boy claimed they weren't given any help by UHC, and that their boy had what they said turned out to be some broken toes.

Hubble said the incident was reported to the Student Advisory Council and the council said it believed no action was needed. He said the health center's insurance prevents them from treating persons who aren't students, even in emergencies.

Hubble said students carrying four credit hours a semester or more are eligible for medical aid from the health center. He said the center cannot treat the spouses and children of students.

"The University health center is financed by students, and is not a general hospital," Hubble said. He said UHC would treat students without IDs, but would charge what private physicians and hospitals would ask for the treatment.

Hubble said UHC would make arrangements to transport someone to a downtown hospital if they had an emergency and were not eligible for the health center treatment.

Hubble also said that between semesters and during the summer students might not be eligible. He said students needed proof that they were enrolled for four hours or more the following semester to be treated during those times.

He said the students who could not prove they were enrolled for the next semester had two options.

They can either pay the \$25 student fee in the winter (\$12.50 during the summer), or they can pay downtown hospital rates.
