Women's health conference slated

To help women take a "decision-making role in their health care," the Lincoln-Lancaster Commission on the Status of Women is sponsoring a Women's Health Conference.

The Oct. 30 conference will cover nutrition, childbirth, breastfeeding, menopause, mental health and how to survive a hospital stay.

"Medicine seems to have gotten out of control of people in general," said Chris Funk, chairwoman of the commission's health committee. "We hope by sharing our experiences we will take away some of the fears women have."

"For instance, the women will be taught that it's okay to question what a doctor tells them and that they don't have to take everything they are told verbatim," Funk said.

All sessions will be led by women who are professionals in their fields, Funk said.

Many of the speakers are local nurses and also serve on the commission's Health Committee.

The commission, initiated by Mayor Helen Boosalis in January, is an advisory commission on the careers, education and personal growth of women.

Women and men of all ages are encouraged to attend the conference at the Havelock-United Methodist Church, 4140 N. 60th St. The committee expects 100 persons to attend.

Child care will be provided by professionals. The registration fee is \$2.
