

Career Day presentations to discuss job possibilities

UNL Builders will sponsor a Career Day Wednesday to give students information about career opportunities.

Presentations by seven UNL colleges will be from 1:30 to 3:30 p.m. in the Nebraska Union Centennial Room. This is the first year for the Career Day presentation.

Builders, a student service and promotional organization, plans to make it an annual event.

Career information presentations will be given by the Engineering, Arts and Sciences, Agriculture, Teachers, Home Economics, Business Administration and Architecture Colleges.

Each college is planning its own presentation to make students aware of career possibilities and alternatives in the college.

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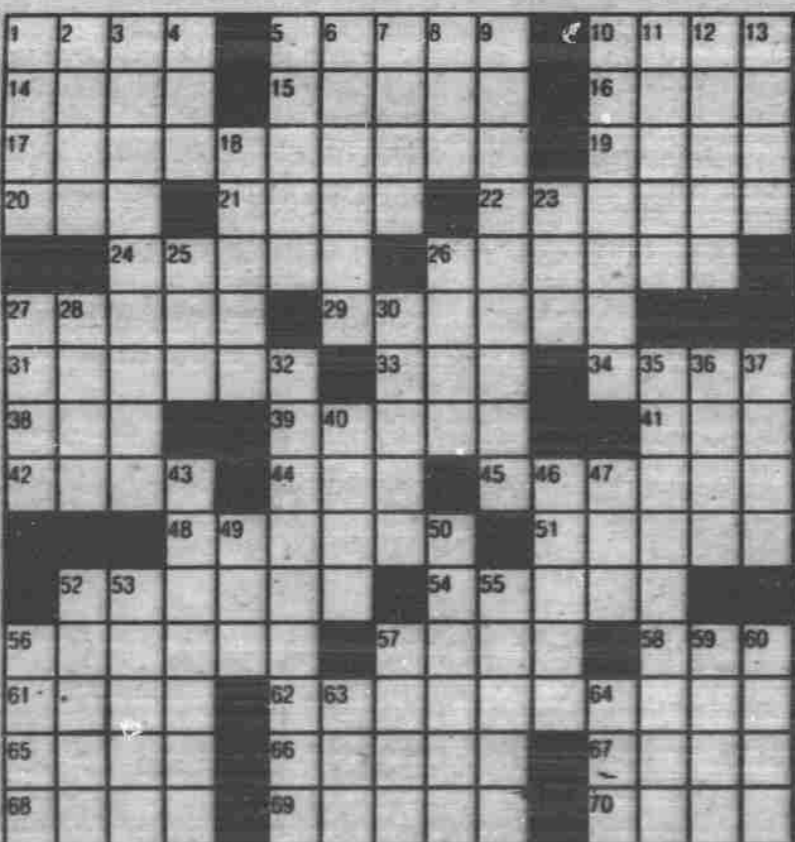
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crossword puzzle
