Semester break action gains wins for UNL's swimmers, wrestlers

The UNL men's swimming and wrestling teams resumed competition during semester break with victories over schools from Missouri and Minnesota.

John Reta's swim team won in its first action since the Big 8 Conference Relays Dec. 3 and 4 by downing Southwest Minnesota State College, 69-44, Thursday in the UNL Sports Complex. The Huskers won seven events and set one new school

Freshman Robbie Ingle set a record of 4:53.179 in the 500-yard freestyle and finished second in the event.

Reta said he was pleased with several of the team members' efforts against Southwest Minnepota State.

"We were pleased in that most of the swimmers either improved their times or equaled old times in the meet. Mike Crowder won the 50- and 100-yard freestyle events and John Dahir knocked three seconds off his 200 butterfly time." "A good meet"

Reta also mentioned freshman Bob Hartford and diver Rick Grahn for their performances in the meet.

"This was a good meet in the sense that we didn't taper any prior to it," Reta said.

"The kids have been working real hard in two-a-day workouts. The workout period in January and December is the most intense work of the season. Once school starts again we'll have to cut back on our workouts."
