"I have no illusion that those who want to drink won't be able to," Kelly said. "There are all kinds of sources for alcohol other than the legal sources.

"If you want to legalize all the drinking that is going on, you'd better set the age at 10 or 12."

'More respectable age Nevertheless, Kelly said he thinks drinkers are in the minority and he is convinced their attitude "would not prevail."

He said the bill should pass so Nebraska could "once again return to a more respectable drinking age.

"It is an excellent time (to change it)

after five years of experimenting with the lowered ages," he said.

The big question, Kelly said, was the action the "tremendously powerful liquor lobby" would take.

He added, however, that he did not think the liquor lobby would oppose the bill because it would be "against what obviously would be the wish of the majority of the citizens of Nebraska."

Persons should evaluate how beneficial the present drinking age has been to both young persons and Nebraskans, he said.
"If it has been beneficial, maintain it,"

he said. "But if it has not, here is an opportunity to say so and change it."
