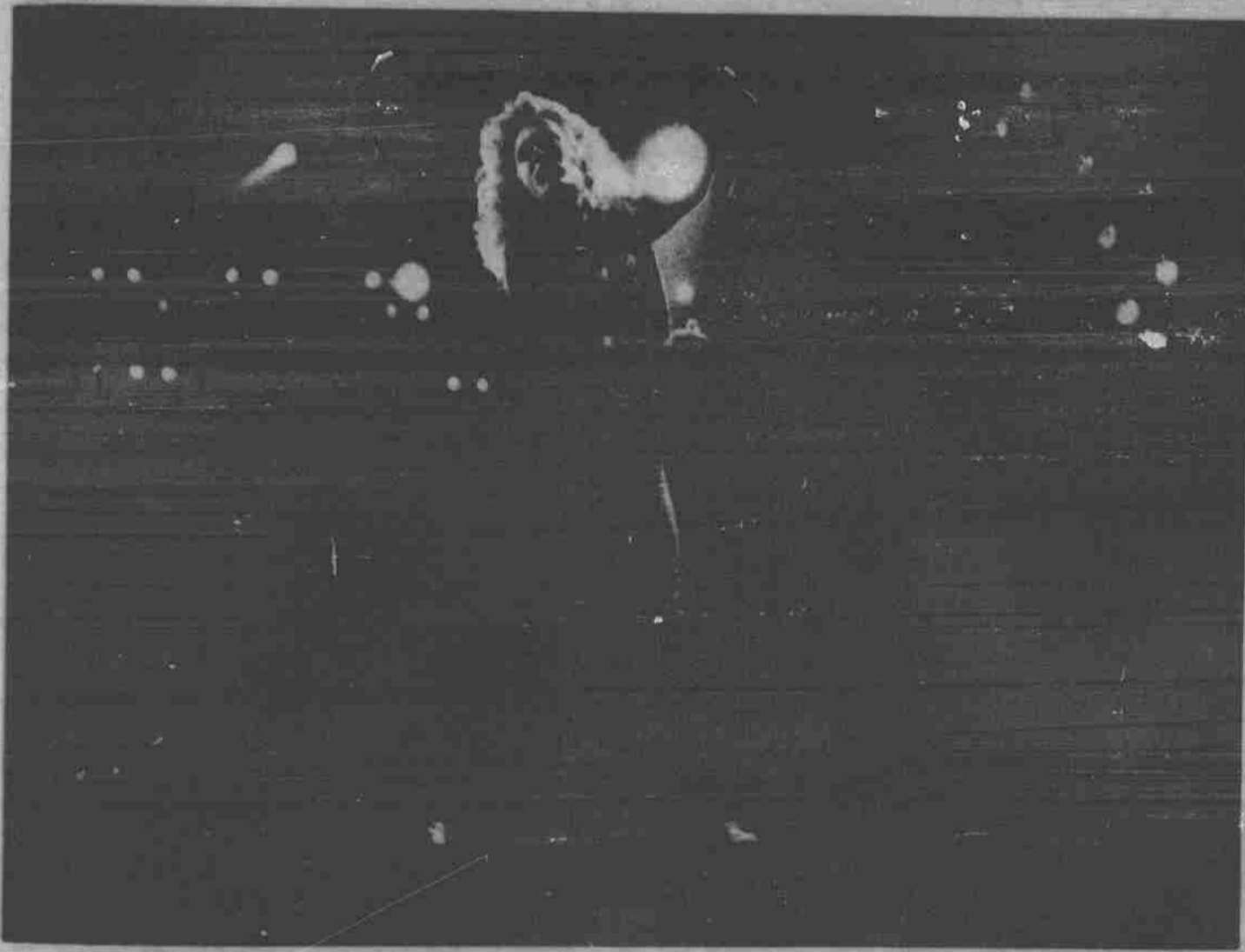
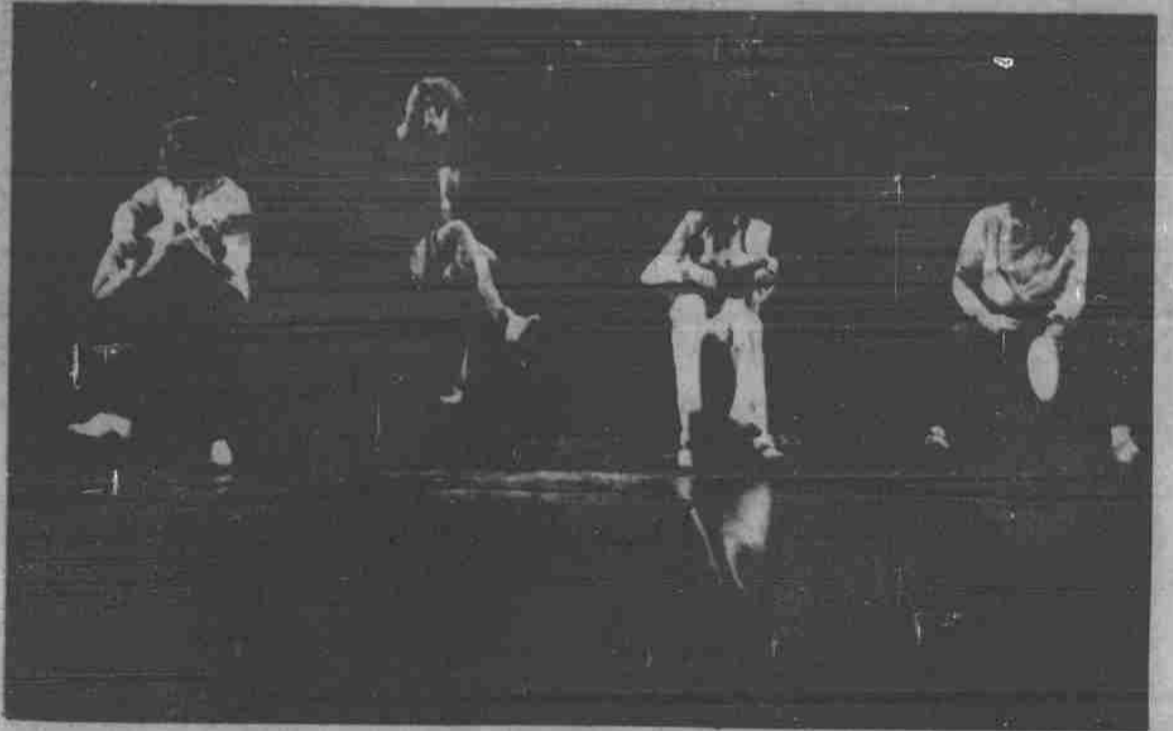




Led n. a heavy, soft, malleable, metallic chemical element. Atomic weight 207.21; Atomic number 82.
