

'Tony Tunes' to premiere

Part of Broadway will come to Lincoln when *Tony Tunes*, an original musical, premieres at the Lincoln Community Playhouse Gallery Theatre today. It runs through Sunday at 8 p.m. with a Sunday matinee performance at 2 p.m.


