**Guard mounts campaign push**

"Get your guard up", and receive half your tuition free, maintains the campaign slogans of the National Guard.

The Air National Guard is striving for a 5 per cent enlistment increase by Sept. 30. The army National Guard is after a 10 per cent increase by the same deadline, said Sergeant Wallace Gant, of the Air National Guard.

The Air Guard currently operates at a 82 per cent capacity. Gant said he hopes for a 96 per cent level.

The threat of falling below 70 per cent operational level is that in case of need, United States aircraft will not have enough people to man the operations, Gant said.

The reason for the decrease in enlistment probably stems back to the draft days, he said. Those who enlisted during the draft are now finishing their enlistment and not enough are enlisting to fill the gap.

Gant said once a person enlists, a male must serve for six years and females must serve for three years.

The initial training includes six weeks at a basic camp and then the person may choose from 400 career fields and continue training in the career of his or her choice.
