Guthrie, Seeger on ETV concert

Arlo Guthrie and Pete Seeger, two of America's most famous folk singers will appear in an hour long concert on the Nebraska Educational Television Network Oct. 1 at 9 p.m.

Taped at the Saratoga Performing Arts Center in Saratoga, New York, the concert features the selections, "Midnight Special," "Goodnight Irene" and "Amazing Grace."

Film footage of the Clearwater sloop, the symbol of Seeger's campaign to clean up the Hudson River will be included in the concert. The concert was held to help raise money for the ecological project, entitled the Hudson River Sloop Restoration, Inc.

Guthrie was born in 1948, 7 years after his famous father, Woody Guthrie, became friends with Seeger. He started singing professionally in 1968 and starred in the film *Alice's Restaurant*, which was inspired by his record of the same name.

Seeger first became interested in folk music in 1935 when he attended a square dance festival. He later traveled around the county with his banjo. After serving in the armed forces, he became famous for his contemporary readings of poetry.
