

Huskers claim title in tourney

The Husker women's volleyball team finished 6-0 in the Big 8's round robin tourney Saturday to claim the Big 8 championship for a second year. UNL, 28-7, downed the University of Missouri, 15-7, 15-7 to key the title defense at Norman, Okla. Earlier this season, the Tigers had beaten the Huskers.

Husker juniors Nancy Wilkinson and Sue Leudtke were named to the all-tourney team.

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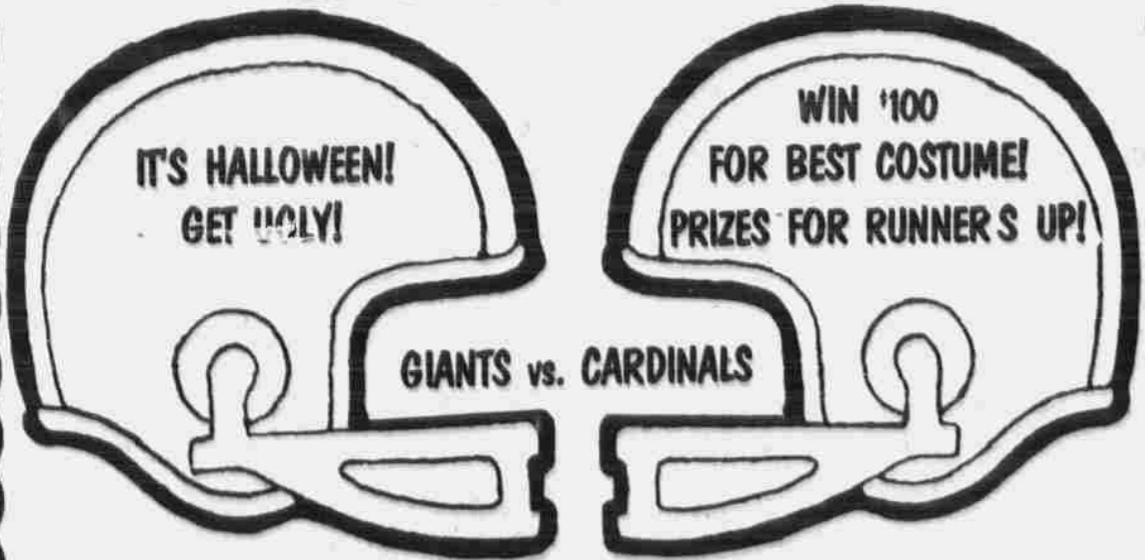
