Fifteen-year-old Peter (Garrett) lives on a trading post operated by his family in the Nebraska Territory in 1861.

After an unsavory character named Lefty Slade leaves a foal at the trading post in payment for a horsehoing job, Peter raises the animal and eventually breaks him for riding.

Peter learns that the Pony Express is seeking accomplished young riders for a difficult and hazardous new route to California and he wins a job after demonstrating his horsemanship.
