

Basketball coaches scouted summer tournaments

The 1978-79 basketball season may have been a long way off, but Husker basketball Coach Joe Cipriano and his staff spent the summer checking out players who might be on that team.

When the summer leagues are over, Cipriano said, the Husker staff has a list of 300 to 400 players that they have looked at.

"We watch a lot of summer leagues and tournaments," Cipriano said. "A lot of the good high school seniors play in leagues during the summer."

Cipriano said the basketball staff subscribes to three basketball scouting services. There are about ten services operating in various parts of the country, he said.

"We sent questionnaires to all the players we are interested in," Cipriano said. "If they write back showing interest in us, then we start making contacts with them."

Cipriano said the major summer tournaments and leagues are in New York, Los Angeles, Chicago, Philadelphia, San Diego, San Francisco, Las Vegas and Phoenix.

"The scouting services save you a lot of work in terms of finding players, Cipriano said. "But then you still have to go take a look at them."


Cipriano said the Huskers again are concentrating their recruiting efforts in Indiana and Wisconsin this season. These states always have a lot of talent, he said.
