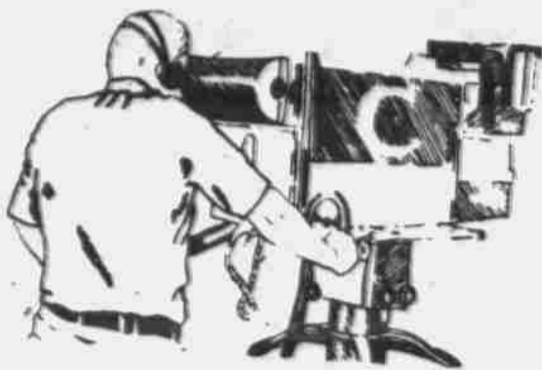

"The Beatles Forever," a Thanksgiving Day salute to the Beatles and their music by eight headliners from this country and England—Diahann Carroll, Ray Charles, Anthony Dowell (of England's Royal Ballet), Anthony Newley, Bernadette Peters and Tony Randall (in photo), Mel Tillis and composer-singer Paul Williams—will be presented on NBC-TV Thursday, Nov. 24.

The program is devoted entirely to the music of the famed English group which in the 1960s changed forever the thrust of popular music all over the world. The Beatles will be seen in a photo montage during the opening minutes of the show.

Stars of the special offer many of the popular Beatles numbers. During a major production segment done in a circus setting, Randall notes: "The music of the Beatles was a veritable treasure trove. One never knew what might pop up next."
