Alfred Hitchcock's latest thriller 'Family Plot' premieres Nov. 26 on 'NBC Saturday Night at the Movies.'

The master of suspense's 1976 film follows the dangerous exploits of a shady medium and her boyfriend (Barbara Harris and Bruce Dern, in photo) searching for the missing heir of an aged, wealthy woman (Cathleen Nesbitt). What the pair doesn't know is that the object of their quarry is a cool jewelry merchant (William Devane) who, with his alluring mistress (Karen Black), engages in a sinister sideline—kidnapping and gem smuggling. What they also don't know is that the jeweler suspects that someone is tracking him down and is plotting to eliminate his pursuers.
