According to First Vice President Charlie Fellingham, the meeting was called to discuss an NU Board of Regents proposal to eliminate student fee funding of University Program Facilities and Fees (UPFF) for use in bringing speakers to UNL.

This semester William Buckley and Jane Fonda were the speakers brought in by the Union Program Council (UPC). UPC receives funds from UPFF. Some regents said their constituents were upset that Fonda was brought in.

Fellingham said the senate could come up with legislation concerning the issue.
