

Bereuter opposes lump sum budget

By the time the University of Nebraska budget winds its way through the legislative process the university will probably be operating on a budget between \$107 and \$109 million. However it is unlikely the money will be allocated in a lump sum as the Governor J. James Exon and the Board of Regents might like.

The governor and the Board of Regents asked the Legislature for \$107,729,233 in a lump sum.

Sen. Douglas Bereuter of Utica, vice chairman of the Legislature's Appropriations Committee, said he opposes giving the Board of Regents complete flexibility with the university budget.

Bereuter spoke to the Government Liaison Committee Tuesday about his opposition to governor's requests.

Bereuter expressed concern that too much money was now being spent in Omaha.

"You (UNL students) should be glad" there is opposition to a lump sum appropriation, he said.

However, Bereuter, said that he hasn't voted against a single appropriation for UNO.

Bereuter also opposes a lump sum allocation because he said he thinks it may prove "politically expedient" for both the governor and the Legislature to blame the Board of Regents if the money were misspent.

Under a lump sum allocation the board would decide how to spend the money on all three campuses.

The board "may find their new freedom rather uncomfortable," Bereuter said.

The majority of the Appropriations Committee agree with his opposition to the lump sum allocation, according to Bereuter.

He said he was not sure of the sentiment of the majority of the Legislature, but said he thought they would follow the committee's recommendation.

"Most of the legislators on the floor are overwhelmed with the intricacies of the budget," he said. "Because of this they generally defer to the committee's position."

UNL, Japanese debaters to meet

Two Japanese debaters will speak at UNL Wednesday at 7:30 p.m. in the Centennial Room of the Nebraska Union.

Shigeru Matsumoto and Tetsuro Toyoda will debate UNL's Leslie McGrew of Omaha and Lance Eldridge of Hutchinson, Kan., on the question of United Nations establishment of an international agency to regulate multinational corporations.

Matsumoto and Toyoda will visit 22 colleges and universities on this tour, according to Debbie Brown,

graduate assistant in charge of the debate team. Their tour is sponsored by the Speech Communication Association and Japanese English and Forensic Association.

Brown said Matsumoto, a junior business administration major from Tokyo, won the Tokyo Intercollegiate Debate League Tournament by beating Toyoda in the final round. Toyoda is a junior English major.

McGrew and Eldridge will represent UNL in a six-state district competition in Marcy to try and earn a spot in national competition.

Admission is free.

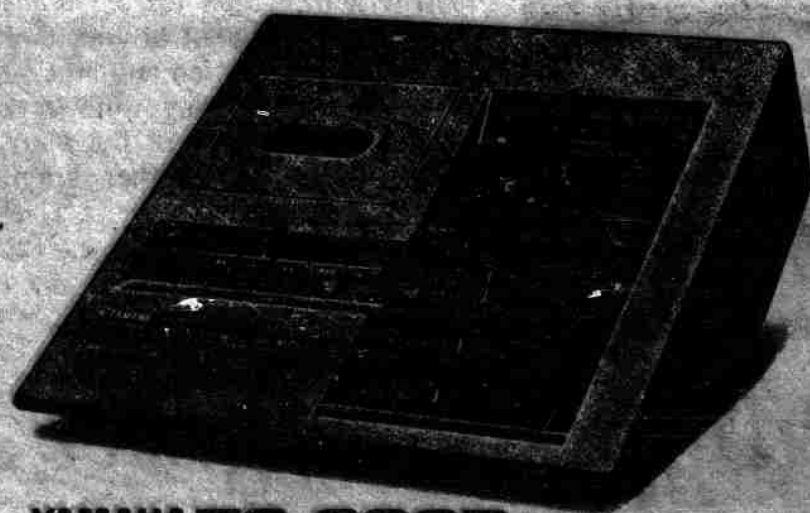
