

# Goodman to make 'City Limits' appearance

During the past decade, Chicago has once again developed into a center of American musical creativity. Steve Goodman has become the spearhead of the Chicago Movement and has been recognized as one of the most talented songwriters of the 70's.

Goodman will appear on *Austin City Limits* over PBS, Feb. 24 at 9 p.m., on Nebraska ETV.

Goodman's songwriting credits include such classic tunes as "You Never Called Me by My Name," recorded by David Allan Coe; "The Twentieth Century is Almost Over," which Goodman wrote and recorded with fellow Chicagoan, John Prine; and "City of New Orleans," Arlo Guthrie's 1972 hit.

Goodman's discovery is credited to Kris Kristofferson, who first heard him perform in Chicago's "Old Town." For months, Kristofferson told friends that he had heard the "greatest pickin' songwriter in the world" while he was in Chicago. Less than two years later, it was Goodman who took Kristofferson to hear John Prine for the first time.

Before signing his first recording contract, Goodman had some lean days. He worked as a jingle writer early in his career and said he remembers when jingles provided his only income.

"When things get too tough on stage now," Goodman said, "I have this medley of jingles that I do."

In his *Austin City Limits* performance, Goodman will treat the audience to some songs from his older albums and several songs from his latest LP, *Say it in Private*. The old selections include "You Never Called Me by my Name," "City of New Orleans" and "Banana Republic." Songs from his new album will be "Men Who Love Women," "The Twentieth Century is Almost Over," and "Video Tape."

*Austin City Limits* is a production of KLRN-TV, San Antonio/Austin and is distributed nationally by the Public Broadcasting Service.

After a torturous courtship they marry and Kate's career as a magazine writer zooms when she goes to work for publisher Tom Feiffer (Theodore Bikel, pictured with Miss Raines). Jenny Reston Norman (Laurie Heineman) leaves Joe (Ben Masters) to search for her own identity and Tanya (Season Hubley), a success in the art world, begins an unhappy relationship with self-absorbed sculptor Mark Stewart (Michael Tolan), an unhappily married man.

Clint Eastwood (pictured) stars as Inspector Harry Callahan, better known as Dirty Harry, a policeman whose tough way with criminals has earned him his nickname and a demotion, in the action drama "Magnum Force," to be rebroadcast on The CBS Tuesday Night Movies Feb. 28.

Callahan is asked to work on the investigation of a wave of gangland murders along with the man who demoted him, Lt. Neil Briggs (Holbrook).

Briggs hints that he suspects a rival mobster (Tony Giorgio) while, based on ballistics evidence, Harry fears that the killer may be a fellow policeman and close friend (Mitchell Ryan). Meanwhile, any or all of a crew of new hotshot rookies are not above suspicion because of their dedicated anti-crime and anti-permissiveness attitudes.
