I grant that macho-sexist exploitation of women is a serious problem. Such sexism must be resisted and ended.

Ms. Stanley's sexist anti-male position is sadly diverse and misleading. Surely she must realize that most men struggle to keep up with their bill-collectors just as women do. Surely Ms. Stanley must realize that most women and men suffer from being bossed around on the job. Again I grant that abuse of women is a serious problem which must be solved, but for Ms. Stanley to ignore the indiscriminate abuse of women and men by profiteering capitalists is either intellectually dishonest or a mark of surprising ignorance on her part.

Let's cast off this brand of female chauvinism and move ahead to exploited men and women uniting together to promote social justice and democracy for all. Certainly we should not follow Ms. Stanley and establish a domineering matriarchy in place of an equally repugnant concept of patriarchy. We do not need new female bosses taking the place of male bosses. We need an end to the concept of bossism and the beginning of a genuine democracy.
