Susan Blakely stars in 'Secrets,' a contemporary 1977 drama of an unhappily married young woman who, because of emotions she cannot understand or control, becomes compulsively promiscuous in a desperate attempt to find the secret of happiness, encoring April 21 on 'The ABC Friday Night Movie.'

The film marked Miss Blakely's first major TV appearance since her Emmy-nominated role in 'Rich Man, Poor Man' two years ago. Also starring are Roy Thinnes, Joanne Linville and John Randolph.

In 'Secrets,' Andrea Fleming (Miss Blakely, pictured), has a seemingly secure life with a successful husband (Thinnes) and a beautiful home. But in reality, Andrea is a tortured woman. Feeling desperately unfulfilled, she succumbs to her sexual fantasies and begins a series of extramarital affairs in an attempt to find the key to happiness which her mother had convinced her was hers for the asking.
