1. Top Value.

Current edition textbooks required for classes at UNL for the upcoming semester are bought back at Nebraska Bookstore at 50% of the regular price. The top value price extends through the regular buyback period at the end of each semester and drops as the quantities for classes are filled.

2. Intermediate Value.

Current edition textbooks which may be used for upcoming semesters but which have not yet been ordered by the instructor are bought at speculative prices between wholesale value and top value. About half of these books will move up in value and half will decrease in value as we get more information on class requirements.

3. Wholesale Value.

Current edition textbooks no longer being used on the UNL campus can often be purchased by Nebraska Book Company for resale to schools in other parts of the United States. Prices on these books vary according to the national demand for each title.

4. Limited Value.

Old edition textbooks and most paperbacks fall into this category. Check our prices and then decide whether or not to keep these books for your personal library or for future reference use.
