

Drug abuse residencies available

Students interested in drug abuse research can apply for a 90-day residency program near Washington, D.C.

Anyone pursuing a bachelor's, master's or doctorate degree in a drug abuse field can apply for the residency at the National Drug Abuse Center (NDAC), according to Linda McNaught of the Nebraska Drug Abuse Commission.

Applicants should have a demonstrated background in drug abuse research or related human service areas such as mental health, parole, probation, or education and training.

The goals of the program, McNaught said, are to involve applicants in various aspects of the drug abuse training system at the policy and decision making levels and to encourage drug abuse training and research.

McNaught said the residency sessions also are part of a general program to involve academic professionals in the training of drug abuse workers. She said many drug abuse workers are ex-addicts or paraprofessionals (below the BA level) who have a "street knowledge" of drug abuse. NDAC wants to combine academic personnel with those who work directly with drug abusers.

McNaught said the summer residency program is in progress but applications for the fall and winter sessions are being taken now. Applications are available at the Nebraska Drug Abuse Commission on the third floor of the State Office Building.

The resident must arrange and pay for academic credit she said. Travel expenses, room and board, NDAC supervision, secretarial support, editorial assistance and office space are paid by NDAC, a branch of the Health, Education and Welfare Department.

A research paper and formal oral presentation are required of all residents at the end of the program, she said.
