## FIVE WEEKS IN A BALLOON



'Five Weeks in a Balloon,' an animated special telling the stirring adventure yarn based on a Jules Verne novel about a courageous trio traveling across the wilds of 19th-century Africa, will be rebroadcast on 'Famous Classic Tales,' Saturday, Sept. 30 on CBS-TV.

In the story Buck, a teenage cowboy from Texas, joins his English uncle Dr. Samuel Fergusson, and an African tribesman Irumu in a race across Africa in a balloon. Their destination is the top of an active volcano, where a fabulous diamond sits on an altar. The gem is a gift from Irumu's tribe to Queen Victoria.

A greedy courtier, the Duke of Salisbury, and his accomplice, an infamous criminal named LeGriffe, set out to reach the diamond first. To assure their own success, the dastardly duo lay threatening traps for our heroes. Nature and geography add their own obstacles as Buck, his uncle and Irumu find fitting challenges to their wits and bravery.
