Dolly Parton wooed New York City for two days recently when she gave a free outdoor concert at City Hall, played the Palladium Theater and dashed in and out of a Studio 54 party held in her honor. Parton was also presented with a key to the city by Mayor Ed Koch. . . Former Roxy Music members Bryan Ferry, Phil Manzanera, Andy Mackay and Paul Thompson have been rehearsing for a reunion album. . . Queen plans to tour the U.S. later this year after finishing a new LP. . .

Nick Lowe's next record and the one he'll produce for Elvis Costello will be out around the New Year. Dave Edmunds' new release *Tracks on Wax 4* will be out soon, followed by a U.S. tour with Nick Lowe. . . England's punk group the Clash recently spent three weeks in San Francisco recording what will probably be their first American album. Then they took off for a look at the country they lacerated in their song "I'm So Bored with the U.S.A."

George Harrison is backing the next Monty Python movie with \$4 million and may even have a role in it. . . *Purple Haze*, the sequel to *American Graffiti*, is being filmed in San Francisco with most of the original cast minus Richard Dreyfus. George Lucas is the executive producer. . . A *Star Wars* TV special later this year will feature Jefferson Starship, without Grace Slick, doing Craig Chaquico's new 'Cigar Shaped Object.' All this from *Rolling Stone* magazine.

TOUR NOTES

The Grateful Dead, who plan a full-scale U.S. tour in November, are off to the Middle East to play three dates at Egypt's Sphinx Theater on Sept. 14, 15 and 16. *Rolling Stone* reports the performances will be recorded for a live album and the tour may result in another Grateful Dead movie.

Neil Young, who hasn't done a major tour since 1976, returns this fall with a 22 day tour in large arenas. Backed by the group Crazy Horse, Young begins Sept. 18 in Clarkston, Michigan and ends October 24 in L.A. His long-delayed *Comes a Time* LP will also be released at that time.

And 10CC, whose new album *Bloody Tourists* will be out this month, begin their first North American tour in two years on Oct. 16 in Winnipeg. The 36 day tour covers the U.S. and Canada and marks the first time the group has played this country since founding members Lol Creme and Kevin Godley left the band.
