DOMINIC



Yorkshire's desolate moors and rugged coastline are the setting for smuggling, kidnapping and murder in the premiere adventure of PBS's 'Once Upon a Classic' series, 'Dominic,' eight half-hour episodes beginning Oct. 7.

In episode one, in 1821, Dominic ('Nick') Bulman (Murray Dale, pictured) is a 16-year-old cadet at Captain Beever's (John Hallam) spartan-like naval academy in Yorkshire, England. Beever, former midshipman to Nick's father Captain Charles Bulman (Richard Todd), is a close friend of the family.

Nick's parents are enroute to their home when their coach is ambushed by highwaymen at Hangman's Hollow. Mrs. Bulman and the coachman are killed, the Captain is wounded and he makes his way to Bulman Hall. But the villains follow him there and the Captain is no match against their pistols in the second battle. His dying words are "eight bells."

Captain Beever has been named Nick's guardian and administrator of the estate. Both he and the boy, unknown to each other, vow to avenge the murders.

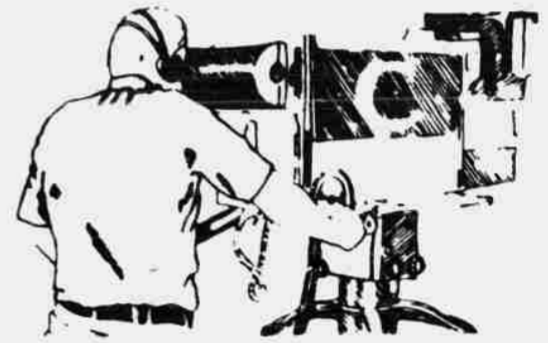
