DOMINIC

In episode one, in 1821, Dominic ('Nick') Bulman (Murray Dale, pic-tured) is a 16-year-old cadet at Captain Beever's (John Hallam) spartan-like naval academy in Yorkshire, England. Beever, former midshipman to Nick's father Captain Charles Bulman (Richard Todd), is a close friend of the family

Nick's parents are enroute to their home when their coach is ambushed by highwaymen at Hangman's Hollow. Mrs. Bulman and the coachman are killed, the Captain is wounded and he makes his way to Bulman Hall. 
