"People look at what has been done with the Omaha Orpheum Theater and cringe when they see what hasn't been done with the Stuart Theater."

Alternate center

Building manager of the Stuart building, Fran Pinkerton, said, "A renovation similar to the Orpheum Theatre in Omaha would be possible to do, but is not at all a definite probability."

The Stuart building, the theater in particular, has had a long history of entertainment in Lincoln.

A combination of short films and live stage performances was the beginning of the theater in June of 1929.

The theater was leased to the Cooper Foundation Theaters around 1933 and continued until April of 1972.

The Dubinsky Brothers Theaters re-opened the Stuart in July of 1972 and has been running it since then.

The Nebraska Foundation currently is using the building for income.

There are six stores of various business on the street floor and nine tenants on the 2nd through 5th floors operating with leases. The foundation has no plans to change this situation at this time and will continue having the building run just as it has been in the past.
