 A large part of the museum's operation is never seen by the public. The vast research collections are stored in Nebraska Hall. The botany collection has long been of note, dating back to the turn of the century when Bessey was here. A more recent and relatively unusual collection is that of the Parasitology Division, "quite rare for a university to have," according to Griesemer.

**Administrative challenge**  
 Balancing the field program, the research and storage facilities, as well as the exhibition demands can pose quite an administrative challenge. Griesemer said it involves dealing with several groups of "independent people" in the various areas of interest, and the trick is "to maximize their potential so it maximizes the potential of the whole museum." Funding comes from both state and private support. Collecting and exhibiting are privately supported, as are many of the programs proposed for the near future, so budgeting can be a complicated matter.

Construction has already begun on the new Health Gallery, which will feature displays new and old about the human body. There will be 3,000 square feet for exhibits and for classroom space to accommodate lectures and demonstrations. To Griesemer, this is "the biggest, the best educational thing we've ever done."

"A strong program will be developed with it, an active program," he said. "We are going to go out and seek people to take advantage of it."

Also in the works is an Encounter Center, "kind of a hands-on place for natural history," as Griesemer puts it. "(It's) a place you can come in and start looking at things, and a place to try to identify things." Specimens will be systematically arranged, so that they can be used for comparison and identification of specimens brought in by members of the public. Plans include a small lab and live animals. It will be useful for special education classes, providing an intimate learning environment. The plans have so far been praised but not funded, though Griesemer adds that hopes are high.

In the future, the Center for Asian Studies will be expanded, and by January a new gallery for Invertebrate Paleontology will be opening, featuring dioramas and a small simulated coal swamp. Griesemer expects further expansions of the public programs. "I think the future is brighter from that standpoint than it's ever been," he said.

The public involvement is very important. The museum has several hundred thousand visitors each year. One of the service aspects of the university is public education, a purpose served admirably by the museum.

"I think we have a lot to offer here," said Griesemer. "I honestly believe it's an important public resource. So if people stopped coming, I'd be bothered personally."
