In the past, the Campus Red Cross and Assistance Team has cleaned up after fires and responded to emergency calls. They respond to red codes; emergency, blue codes; missing person, and yellow codes; fire clean up.

The ten-member team, is located on East Campus in Burr Hall, Courtright said.

"We are not replacing the Health Aides (in the residence halls), we're here to help them out in situations in which they are not fully equipped to handle,"

The team has its own equipment including blankets and splints, which, he said, is more than what the Health Aides have.

"Dr. Armstrong, vice chancellor of affairs, is in full support of our program," Courtright said. "We are still new and trying to become recognized as a valid team is important to us.
