Finding the dummy in "The Dummy" takes a little time. It might be the humanoid bought by the narrator. More likely it's the narrator himself, who earnestly congratulates himself for foisting all his responsibilities upon a substitute. Sontag's story is another subdivision in the new tract of moral fables: sci-fi.

Sontag's last full-length work of fiction was *Death Kit* (1967). She has become even more refined since then, less obliged to follow a leader. *I, etcetera* is her first virtuoso recital.
