Nebraska's Sue Sloboth defeated Holly Walkup of Iowa State, 6-2, 6-1, and Sue Moore defeated Oklahoma State's Kris Christopher, 6-3, 6-1, to win the singles consolation championships at the Big Eight Women's Tennis tournament in Lawrence, Kan.

The duo had been defeated earlier by Nancy Fudenberg and Nancy Dickens in the third-place doubles competition.

Head basketball Coach Joe Cipriano

completed his recruiting by inking 6-foot-10, 230-pound forward Lance Berwald from Washburn High School in Minneapolis, Minn.

Berwald averaged 21.4 points and 17.9 rebounds and shot 66 percent from the field and 70 percent from the free throw line.

The signing of Berwald exhausts Nebraska's quota of scholarships and ends specu-

lation about the possible return of two-year letterman Gerard Myrthil. If Myrthil does return, it will be as a walk-on.

Berwald is the sixth player to sign a national letter of intent with the Cornhuskers. The Cornhuskers also signed 6-foot-2½ all-state guard Greg Downing from Central High School in Duluth, Minn., 6-foot-2 Eric Williams from Washington High School in South Bend, Ind., 6-foot-4 Church Anderson from North Platte, 6-foot-4 Tim West, a trans-

fer from State Fair Community College in Sedalia, Mo., and seven-footer David MacFarlane from Plattsmouth.

The Nebraska men's tennis team won matches against Missouri, 5-4, and Baker University, 7-2, Saturday in Columbia, Mo. The men's record now stands at 10-8. Coach Jim Porter's netters will be in Topeka, Kan., Saturday for dual matches with Washburn University and McPherson College.
