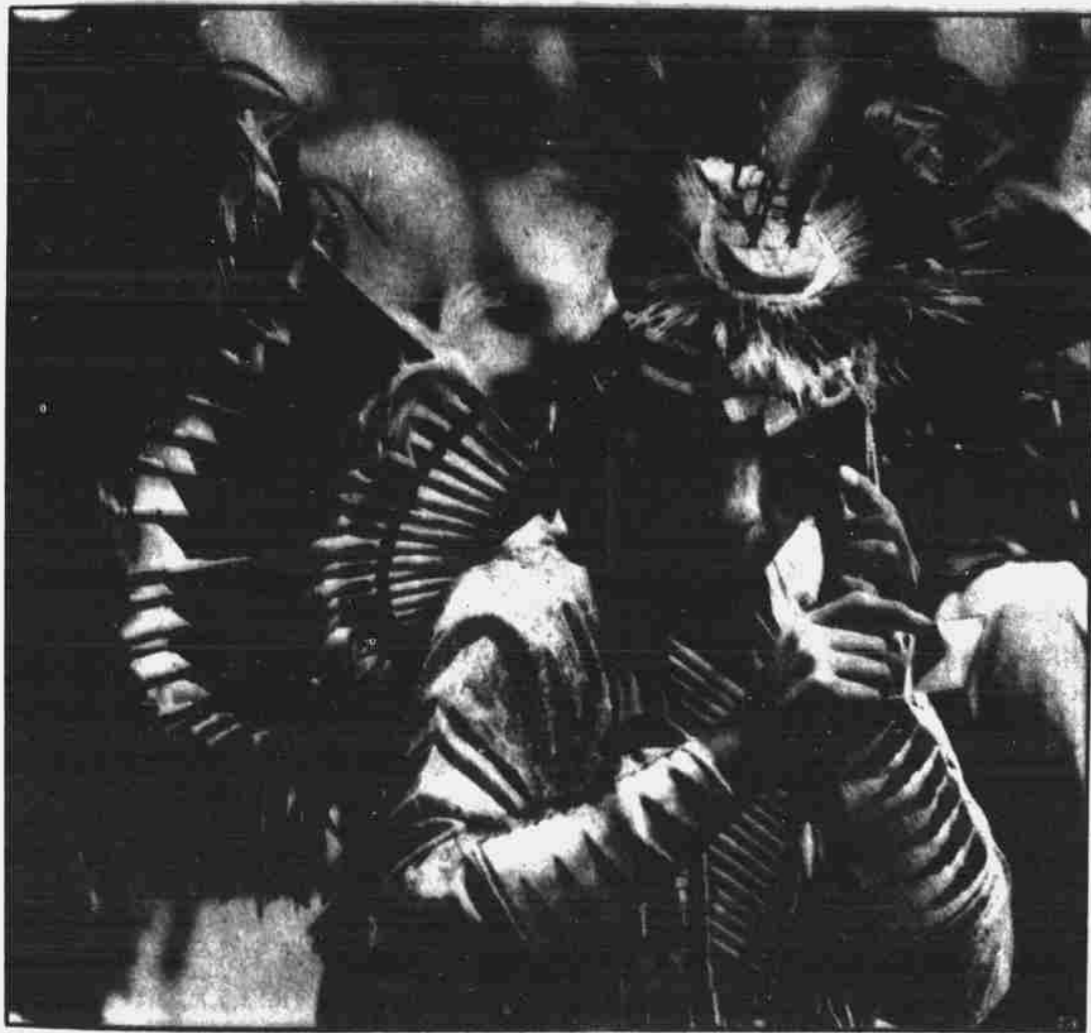




Traditional Indian dancing highlights contemporary arts and sciences festival
