

# Hipple, not Hipp, Utah State threat: UNL end coach

If Eric Hipple, Utah State's quarterback, happens to get the flu and can't make it to Lincoln this weekend, George Darlington said he wouldn't be particularly upset.

Darlington, UNL's defensive end coach told the Extra Point Club Monday that Hipple, who accounted for 401 yards out of Utah State's 538 total offensive yards in the Aggie's 48-48 tie with San Jose State last Saturday, is the team's franchise.

Darlington traveled to San Jose, where he was a former coach, to scout Utah State, the Huskers' first opponents this season.

"Hipple is an excellent quarterback and will be drafted high in the pros. He can throw and run well," Darlington said.

Hipple threw 44 passes, completed 25 and threw one interception Saturday. He is the second all-time leading passer in Utah State history.

Despite the tie with San Jose, Utah State had the better team, Darlington added.

He said their offense looked stable and was able to execute diverse plays without many penalties.

Once out of the huddle, the offense would shift formations, Darlington said. They shifted six different ways which easily can confuse a defense, he explained.

The Aggies second best player, according to Darlington, is kicker Steve Steinke.

Steinke is the NCAA top returning field goal kicker since the graduation of Penn State's Matt Bahr last year.

"During warm up he was kicking at least 70-yard field goals," Darlington observed.

Darlington said the Aggies have a "reasonably good" offensive line and have two or three wide receivers with good speed.

However, he said it was difficult to tell

how good Utah State's defense was because of the "unorthodox way San Jose played the game."

"There were times when they would come out of the huddle and go into a formation without a backfield," he said.

The defense was "rattled" and was not prepared to deal with the unusual formations, he added.

He said that All-American candidate Rulon Jones, a defensive tackle was not a stand out in the game.

"He's big (6-7, 265-pounds) and it's hard to ignore that," Darlington said.

Husker tackle Dan Steiner at 6-1, 255-pounds will line-up against Jones this weekend.

Nebraska Head Coach Tom Osborne said that a scramble block may be the best way to stop Jones and added that Steiner "may just surprise you."

"I feel like a broken record but all I can say now before playing a game, is that I think we will have a fine team this year," Osborne noted.

"Defensively, we will be a little bit better than last year because we returned so many people up front," he said.

Offensively, he said he is pleased with the progress of quarterback Jeff Quinn.

Quinn, a junior from Ord, will start his first game for the Huskers Saturday. "If he doesn't play well, I'm not going to give up on him because it is his first game," he said.
