Dormitory to raffle tuition, survival kits

By spending as little as 33 1/3 cents, you can win up to \$360 of your spring semester tuition. That is the grand prize of the raffle sponsored by students of second floor Cather Hall, beginning Thursday.

Lynn Wilson, production director of the raffle, said that the raffle is unusual because its prize is tuition, whereas most raffles award gifts.

The raffle includes second and third prizes, which Steve Hardy, publicity director for the raffle, called a "student survival kit."

The "kit" includes such delicacies as McDonalds gift certificates and haircuts. Second prize is \$75 worth of survival aids and third prize is worth \$25.

Hardy said the raffle will be financed primarily through ticket sales, and that the dormitory students hope to break even.

Six thousand tickets have been printed and are selling three for a dollar. 10 percent of the profits will go to the UNL All University Fund, Hardy said.

Tickets can be purchased in both unions, and also will be sold in the food service lines in the residence hall. Sales begin Thursday at 11 a.m., with a musical kick-off by some residents of Cather 2.

The tuition recipient will be chosen Nov. 2, and announced on Nov. 7 at 11 a.m. in the Nebraska Union.


