Cowboy 'brawl' could be tougher game than Kansas

Nebraska's 42-0 romp over Kansas really didn't surprise many people. The rout was typical of the Huskers' scores against the Jayhawks over the past ten years.

Except for a 10-9 decision in 1973 and a 160 shutout in 1975 (both in Lincoln) NU has defeathered fne 'Hawks with relative ease.

The remaining eight scores look like an Oklahoma-Rice or Virginia-James Madison (a Division II school the Cavaliers beat 69-9 Saturday) matchup.

Nebraska has whipped the Jayhawks 55-0, 56-0, (twice), 31-3, 52-7, 63-21, 42-0 and a meager 41-20 in 1970 when the Cornhuskers won the national champion-

So the 42-point win Saturday was just tied for the fifth highest victory margin in the past ten years. Last year's spread was also 42 (63-21 in Lawrence), but it was the total yardage difference which has been astounding the past two years.

Nebraska has piled up 1,410 yards in the last two meetings, including the all-time Big Eight record of 799 yards set last year.

KU has gained 999 yards less than the Huskers in the last two meetings. The Jayhawks mustered only 79 yards in total offense Saturday and have only 90 yards rushing in two tries against the Huskers.

Although Kansas was again a pushover for Nebraska, Oklahoma State's Cowboys figure to treat the Huskers like a "bar room brawl" come Saturday. At least that's what NU defensive coordinator Lance Van Zandt called the matchup before last year's game.

The most recent scores against the Cowboys show that the game is an annual brawl.

A good example is last year's 22-14 escape by the Huskers in Lincoln. Oklahoma State had the ball on the 19-yard line late in the fourth quarter. But a pass into the end zone was thrown over an open receiver's head and Nebraska hung on for the win.

The Cowboys, who came to Lincoln with a 2-5 record, out-downed NU 17-15 last year and out-yarded the Huskers 323 to 316.

Except for Nebraska's national championship years, Oklahoma State has been considerably tougher to handle than the Jayhawks.

Nebraska beat the Cowboys 65-31 in 1970 and 41-13 in 1971 en route to national titles. NU posted a 34-0 shutout in 1972.

Tom Osborne's first year, the wins haven't come easy. Nebraska has won in Lincoln by four-point margins twice-7-3 in 1974 and 14-10 in 1976-and doubled that margin in last year's triumph.

In Stillwater the Huskers have another eight-point win, 28-20 in 1975, and a 31-14 victory in 1977 when Nebraska's defense stopped OSU All-American Terry Miller.

OSU, now 3-2 on the season, looks primed for Nebraska again after knocking off 15th-ranked Missouri, 14-13, Saturday in Colombia. The Cowboys, who supposedly have less depth than anyone in the Big Eight, may turn out to be the surprise of the season in the confer-
