The Undergraduate Psychological organization will hold elections Wednesday at 3:30 p.m. in Burnett 223.

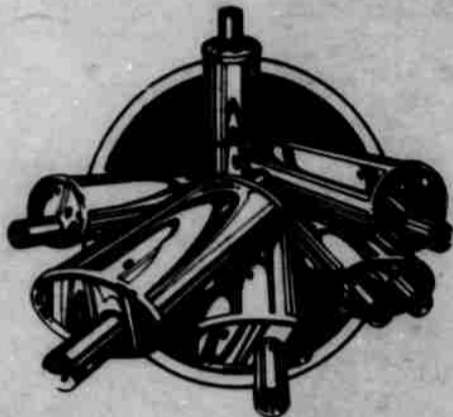

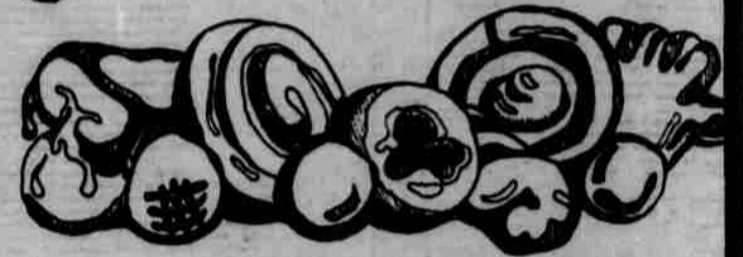
