The Huskers, who are the defending NCAA champions, were led by freshman sensation Phil Cahoy, and 9th world-rated gymnast Jim Hartung; together with Steve Elliott, Mark Williams, Chuck Chmelka, Scott Johnson, Kevin Dunkley, Frank Hibbits, Jim Winkelmann and Mark Hobson, scored 275.70 points and captured four of six first places.
