

Job service helps find summer workers

Lincoln and other Nebraska employers may find help obtaining student summer workers through the UNL Job Locator Service, according to Gail Wheeler, administrator of the service.

By telling the UNL Job Locator Service of their summer employee needs, businesses can get a wide selection of applicants, Wheeler said.

Over 110 students found employment through the UNL Job Locator Service last year, she said.

"Students are willing to do various kinds of work. They're motivated about financing their education," she said, adding that in the past they have filled career-

oriented jobs as well as clerical, farm, recreational and food service positions.

"Students generally find temporary summer jobs enjoyable," she added, noting that students usually will accept either a full or part-time job in Lincoln.

"Students usually take classes if they are only working part-time," she said.

Potential employers in other Nebraska Communities would probably need to offer students a full-time job in order to cover their living expenses, unless the job is in the student's home town, Wheeler said.
