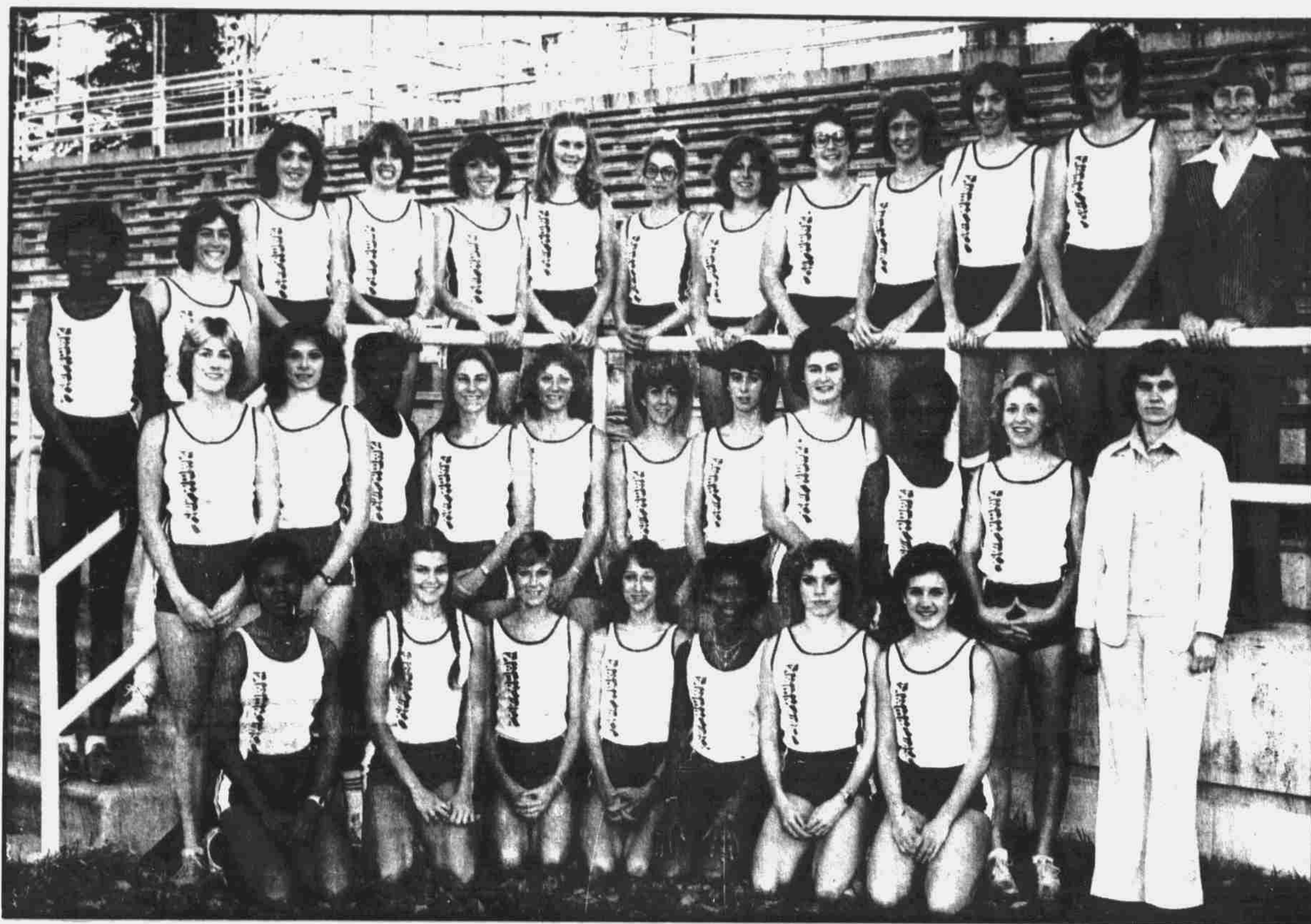


At COORS, People make the difference
