Increase in income countered by inflation

During the 1980 second quarter, personal income for Nebraskans was five percent higher than at the same time in 1979. But this failed to keep pace with inflation, according to the UNL College of Business Administration's Bureau of Business Research.

According to figures released by the U.S. Department of Commerce, personal income for Nebraskans was \$14.3 billion for the second quarter 1980.

Jerome Deichert, research associate for the bureau, said Nebraska's increase compares to a 10 percent increase at the national level. The primary reason for this smaller increase for the state was attributed to a 3.2 percent drop in farm income.
