Men's indoor track coach expects close first contest

The men's indoor track team begins its season at home Saturday against what Coach Frank Sevine calls a traditionally strong Southern Illinois team and a good Kansas State team.

"This is an excellent meet to start the season off with," Sevine said. "I expect a very close meet for all three teams."

The Cornhuskers are coming into the meet warmed from the USA Indoor Championships in Kansas City, Mo. last week. Pole vaulter Mark Newton had a vault of 17'4", which is the best in the Big Eight. His vault also qualified him for the NCAA Indoor Championships March 13 in Detroit.

Joe Staab in the shot put and Randy Raymond in the pole vault also qualified with marks of 59-5 and 16-8, respectively. Other Huskers to watch, according to Sevine are Randy Brooks in the 60-yard high hurdles and Everton Decosta in the 600-yard dash.

"We have a well-balanced team with many back from last year, so I expect to have a strong team this season," Sevine said.

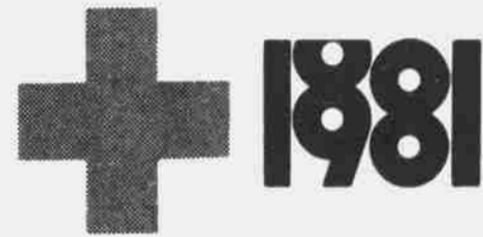
Back from last year for

Southern Illinois is David Lee, who is fifth in the world in the 400 meter hurdles with a time of :48.87. Lee also was on the U.S. Olympic team last summer. Also back for Southern Illinois is high jumper Stephen Wray, who

has a best of 7-3.

Top performances for KSU in its duel with Kansas two weeks ago included Ray Bradley's shot put of 61-0, Steve Wright's time of :30.93 in the 300-yard dash, and Doug Lytle with a pole vault of 16-8 1/2.
