Official's conservatism stems from economics

Lancaster County and Lincoln have undergone dramatic demographic changes in elected officials through the 1970s. County Treasurer Dick Nuernberger is representative of this trend.

"I'm a conservative Republican," said Dick Nuernberger, who was elected in 1978. "Last year I ran for delegate to the convention pledged to Reagan.

"My main reason for being conservative is economics," he said. "I think that it is much more important to promote business growth than it is to spend money on social programs that don't work anyway.

"I would rather avoid talking about social issues," he said, "but I do have to say that there's no way I could tell a woman about abortion-that's her decision."

Nuernberger graduated from UNL with a business degree in 1973 after a term of military service.

"I was having a bad semester academically," he said, "so I decided that instead of wasting money on another semester's tuition, to enlist.

"I ended up doing support duty for the Vietnam War in Guam," he said, Nuernberger was a student during the

heyday of student protest. "I went to some rallies against the war. mainly out of curiosity, but I was never a big college liberal or even that political at the time," he said.
