GENERAL TRIP INFORMATION
Sign-ups: Most trips simply require filling out an application and submitting a deposit of 30% (non-refundable) of the total trip cost. Some trips require interview. Limit 8-12 students.
Cost: Varies with expense and length of each trip, but generally will cover trip food, transportation, equipment, guides, insurance, etc. Costs of trips do not include traveling meals.
Food: Generally, a typical UNL trip will cover all camping meals. Participants must pay for traveling meals.
Insurance: Trip insurance provided.
Equipment: All trip equipment and most personal equipment is provided and included in the trip cost.
